The Conference OBJECTIVE is to intensify the information exchange of the results in theoretical research and practical developments in the field of the e-Learning and mLearning. e-Learning'15 is organized under the patronage of the EUROPEAN COMMISSION - Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency and John Atanasoff Union of Automation and Informatics. E-learning'15 will be organised in between 11-12 September 2015, University of Applied Sciences, Berlin, Germany. Fourth project meeting with the partners will take place during the conference as well. Thus together with host of this organisation an intense work have been implemented to organise international conference, workshop and project meeting under the leadership of the project coordinator.
